**Narrative**

UPDATED INFORMATION 8/20/19 1630 hrs - The cause of the fire could not be determined due to the extensive damage sustained during the fire. The fire appears to have been accidental but the exact cause could not be determined. Bend Fire Department received multiple 911 calls about a house on fire on Golden Meadow Loop early Tuesday morning. The house was fully involved when crews arrived. The family had safely evacuated the home prior to our arrival. Crews worked for nearly an hour to fully contain the fire. The fire cause is still under investigation at this time. More information to come after the investigation is completed. Bend Fire Department reminds everyone to review their insurance policies on a regular basis to ensure proper coverage of your home and belongings. Other tips that can help in the event of a fire is to put important documents into a fire resistant safe, back up computer files off site to the cloud or similar in case the computer is damaged, and keeping an inventory of your homes contents. This can be accomplished with video, photos and lists and then store those in a safe location or off site. All of these can help in the recovery process. The owners here had much of this accomplished and were even able to salvage important documents that were thought to be lost in the fire.
