Narrative

Bend Fire Department responded with the assistance of BLM and Alfalfa Fire to a reported fire north of Deschutes Junction this evening. Smoke was spotted by a USFS Lookout shortly after 5pm then a neighbor called in the fire a few minutes later. Crews arrived and found a fire in brush behind the home at 21598 Morrill Rd. The neighbor that called in the fire was helping to keep the fire from spreading with hand tools when crews arrived. The fire was stopped quickly and kept well away from any structures. No damage to any property was noted. The fire was caused by a lightning struck tree that was believed to be struck during Sunday's large thunder storm. The strike held over until this afternoon.
