Description of Incident: Bend Fire responded to a report of an appliance fire in a single family home on the North side of Bend. The occupants reported hearing unusual sounds from their microwave as it was warming food. As they investigated the sound, they discovered the unit was on fire. The first arriving company reported a microwave on fire, spreading to the cabinets. Firefighters knocked the fire down with fire extinguishers. There was smoke damage on the first floor. The cause is believed to be failure of the microwave, which is 20 years old. Bend Fire wants to remind people to evacuate a house when a fire is discovered, call 9-1-1 and do not re-enter the structure once you are out.
