The Bend Fire Department responded on a report of a residential structure fire when multiple people called 911. The occupant, who is also the owner, heard noise from the attic/roof area and went outside to investigate and found fire coming from the roof. The occupant was able to escape with his dog to safety. The fire crew arrived to see fire coming from the roof and back side of the residence. Crews were able to rescue a cat from inside the residence and the cat was transported to a vet evaluation. Upon investigation, the fire was believed to start from ashes from his wood stove that was put on the porch near his wood pile. The fire caught the wood pile on fire and then the fire extended to the house and ultimately the attic. Bend Fire and Rescue would like to remind everyone to properly dispose of hot ashes. Please keep them away from the house and combustible material. We would also like to remind the community to have working smoke detectors in the home. Working Smoke detectors save lives.
